1.49	Delete section.	Term "Rural" is not used anywhere else in agreement. Resulted in subsequent renumbering of following sections.

2.1	Changed reference on Exhibit identifier to read "C"	Two exhibits were removed from the agreement, thus necessitating subsequent relettering of exhibit identifiers.
3.3	Added language that clarifies use of QRV.	Current language allows for the use of QRV. New language clarifies use of QRV, requires Agency approval, and ensures that ALS ambulance is still sent to all code 2 and 3 calls.

4.1	Language added that ensures contract will be executed for dispatch services.	Ensures development of dispatch agreement.
4.5	Deleted section.	Language was specific to start up of contract. Specific details regarding this section are now included in dispatch agreement. Required renumbering of subsequent sections.
6.2	Moved language from Section 6.2.1 into Section 6.2`	Makes agreement structure consistent throughout document.
6.11	Deleted section.	Language was specific to first agreement.
6.12	Deleted section.	Language was specific to first agreement.
8.4	Language revised to ultimately require daily submission of data. Language also details that data will continue to be submitted monthly until data transmission system is configured. Revision also requires submission of CEMSIS data elements and other elements as requested by Agency.	MVEMSA will be establishing a new data collection that necessitated new reporting processes.
13.2	Section revised to include current response time language that was developed after first year of service.	Old language was deleted and amendment language developed in 2006 was inserted.
13.2.1	Language added to make agreement consistent with current agreement that was amended in 2006.	Amendment language developed in 2006 was inserted.
13.3	Section revised to delete reference for development of response time criteria. Language added to clarify role of EMSOC in the assessment of fines.	Language was specific to original agreement. Clarification added regarding role of EMSOC.
13.6.7	Language added that clarifies that QRV may stop the clock, if approved by the Agency.	Current language allows for the use of QRV. New language clarifies use of QRV, requires Agency approval, and ensures that ALS ambulance is still sent to all code 2 and 3 calls.

15.8	Language deleted that references agreement renewal.	Language specific to original agreement. This agreement cannot be renewed.
16.2.7	Language added to clarify “vehicle” maintenance and management advice from provider. Language deleted regarding administrative consulting and management services.	Language clarification regarding intent of section.
17.9	Section deleted.	Calaveras dispatch does not meet current Commission on Ambulance Accreditation Standards(CAAS) and CAAS will therefore not accredit providers.
