Description: The course will provide operational-level training for EOC or DOC Plans and Intelligence Section staff serving in the Resource or Demobilization Units. Resource Unit Leader section of this course is designed to train an individual to manage a resource unit. Contents include gathering and preparing resource status information, preparation of resource displays, and preparation of the Incident Action Plan. The Demobilization Unit Leader section of this course is designed to train personnel in the management skills and responsibilities of a Demobilization Unit Leader. Emphasis is placed on development and implementation of the Incident Demob Plan. The course is 28 hours and attendees will receive National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) certification.

Instructors: Judy Forbes served as a Type 1 Planning Section Chief for 15 years and has over 30 years experience in the Federal Fire Service. Judy is qualified as a lead instructor with 20 years experience training the Incident Command System. Robert Klinoff is qualified as a Safety Officer Type 1 and Incident Commander Type 2. Bob has over 33 years experience in the fire service including Emergency Operations Center experience as the Director, Operations Section Chief and Branch Director.

Target Audience: Personnel assigned to a Plans & Intelligence Section in an Emergency Operations Center or Department Operations Center during disaster response. Class size is limited. Registration priority will be for Stanislaus Operational Area personnel.

Pre-requisite: Completion of: ICS 300 / ICS 400
