Upon successful completion of all items listed in the checklist below the candidate will be issued EMT-I Certification for a two year period.

- Submit a signed application for Initial EMT-I Certification.
 - Provide a copy of a current driver's license or a government issued identification card.
 - Provide a copy of current National Registry Certification.
 - Complete a California Department of Justice Background Check (DOJ).
 - Payment of \$30.00 certification fee

EMT-I RECERTIFICATION CHECKLIST

Upon successful completion of all items listed in the checklist below the candidate will be issued EMT-I Certification for a two year period.

- Submit a signed application for EMT-I Recertification.
 - Provide a copy of a current driver's license or a government issued identification card.
 - Copy (front and back) of current CPR Certification taught to the curriculum standards of the American Heart Association, American Red Cross or the National Safety Council at the Health Care Provider or equivalent level.
 - Submit completed EMT-I skills competency verification form.
 - Submit documentation of twenty-four (24) hours of continuing education.
 - Complete a California Department of Justice Background Check (DOJ), ***if not previously on file with the agency.***
 - Payment of \$30.00 recertification fee. \$15.00 late fee if application not submitted 15 days prior to expiration date.

EMT-I RECIPROCITY CERTIFICATION CHECKLIST

An individual currently certified as an EMT-I in the State of California will be issued reciprocity Certification upon successful completion of all items listed in the checklist below. The certification expiration date will be the same as the expiration date of the certification used to obtain reciprocity certification.

- Submit a signed application for EMT-I Reciprocity Certification.
 - Provide a copy of a current certification as an EMT-I in the State of California.
 - Provide a copy of a current driver's license or a government issued identification card.
 - Complete a California Department of Justice Background Check (DOJ).
